

CT Dance School Safety Guidelines

Before registering for Fall 2020 classes, we ask that you take time to read these guidelines in their entirety. Your health and safety come first. These CT guidelines are issued by the state and we ask that you follow them to ensure everyone's safety. Thank you!

Please Wear a Mask

- You must wear a mask while in the studio.
- Masks must be worn if you are going to the bathroom or leaving early.
- Masks are only available if you forget yours. If you forget your mask please go to the main office before going into your class.

Please Practice Social Distancing

- Each CDS studio is floor taped to provide 6 feet social distance between dancers.
- Dance programs beginning class times are staggered to help maintain social distancing.
- Students will enter through one entrance and leave through another. (Specifics will be sent to those who enroll.)
- Clients and employees shall stay home if they have a fever, are ill, or have been experiencing symptoms of a cough, sore throat, fatigue, body aches, etc.

Class Capacity & Social Distancing

- Studio 1: 14 students maximum (6ft social distance)
- Studio 2: 12 students maximum (6ft social distance)
- Studio 3: 6 students maximum (6ft social distance)

CT Dance School Safety Guidelines (*cont.*)

Staff Cleaning & Disinfecting

- The floor will be cleaned after each class with a germicide disinfectant cleaner.
- Door knobs and ballet barres will be cleaned after every class.
- The front doors, side doors and back door will be open before and after class for contactless entry.
- The bathroom will be disinfected each morning and at the end of classes with germicide disinfectant cleaner.
- There will be hand-sanitizing stations located near the main entrance and in the studios.
- Please wash your hands.
- Drinking fountains will not be available. Bring your own water.

Rules for Entering CDS and Leaving CDS

- Everyone's temperature will be checked upon entering the building.
- Parents and siblings are to remain outside the school unless they have made an appointment with the office.
- Please use the hand sanitizer in the main lobby or your designated entrance before walking further.
- Street shoes should be removed before entering the studios.
- Students should enter the studio one at a time and follow the social distancing markers labels on the floor.
- After class do not linger or congregate in or outside the studio.

What each Student Should Bring to CDS

1. Bring your own water bottle.
2. Bring your own mask and gloves.
3. Come dressed in uniform. The dressing rooms will be closed.
4. Bring a bag to place your street shoes in.
5. Students who are attending in-person classes must sign a in-person class waiver.
